- 4. Further Plan details for future project- Worksites**
 - It was decided at this time to focus on the Municipalities as worksites in York County. There are approximately 67.
 - An introduction Letter will be sent out with several goals- To raise awareness of who TFYC is and what we do, ask about current worksite Tobacco free Policies, and provide education regarding Tobacco/Vaping, including smoke free environments. An Infographic will also be created.
 - Sarah Lehman and Pam are to draft a letter that can be sent to the worksites
 - Laurie and Susan are going to draft an infographic that depicts importance of worksites having tobacco free policies
