 - Leah- WellSpan is now live in Epic- increasing referral streams. The American Lung Association grant funding has been extended through the end of June 2021.

 - Bob- Hoping to have more public Narcan distribution events- one scheduled in Delta on March 30 from 3-6 pm
- 2. February meeting recap**
 - Members celebrating anniversary of Tobacco-Free York County and highlighted achievements. After, members worked on writing recommendations for worksite letter revision.
- 3. TFYC website review-** The website page was shared virtually by Leah to highlight the changes that have been made. Group discussed format of website if viewing on a mobile device. After investigation, determined it still looked good. Changes were approved with a few changes still needing to be added

- 4. Revisit worksite plan- review changes to letter and determine plan of action to move forward-** After discussion around the worksite plan, it was voted to defer the worksite project until another time. There seems to be a more immediate need for tobacco cessation efforts centered around Behavioral Health:
